**An Act to amend the Education Act 1989 by acknowledging the role of Te Aho Matua in Kura Kaupapa Maori**

**BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows.**

**1 Short Title and commencement**

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Education (Te Aho Matua) Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Education Act 1989 (“the principal Act”).
