**1      Title**

This Act is the Judicature Amendment Act 2007.

**2      Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

This Act amends the Judicature Act 1908.

**4 Age of retirement**

Section 13 is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”.

**5 Rights on retirement before attaining retiring age**

Section 14 is amended by omitting “68” in each place where it appears and substituting in each case “70”.

**6 Vacation of office**

Section 26E(3) is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”.

**7 Temporary Associate Judges**

Section 26H(3) is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”.
