The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**
This Act is the Human Rights Amendment Act 2007.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
- 3 Principal Act amended**
This Act amends the Human Rights Act 1993.

4 Condition in restraint of marriage

- (1) The heading to section 136 is amended by adding “, **civil union, or de facto relationship**”.
- (2) Section 136 is amended by omitting “marriage” and substituting “a person from marrying or entering into a civil union or de facto relationship”.
- (3) Section 136 is amended by inserting “or enter into a civil union or de facto relationship with” after “marry”.
