Order

1 Title

This order is the Road User Charges (Exemption Period for Light Electric RUC Vehicles) Order 2012.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 1 August 2012.

3 Interpretation

In this order, **Act** means the Road User Charges Act 2012.

4 Exemption period for light electric RUC vehicles

For the purposes of section 37 of the Act, the period during which road user charges are not payable in respect of light electric RUC vehicles is the period—

- (a) beginning on the commencement of this order; and
- (b) ending with the close of 31 March 2024.

Notes

1 *General*
