**Order**

**1 Title and commencement**

- (1) This order may be cited as the Companies Special Investigations Order (No 6) 1989.
- (2) This order shall come into force at 6 pm on 3 April 1989.

**2 Release of certain companies from application of Companies Special Investigations Act 1958**

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force at 6 pm on 3 April 1989, relates to the Equiticorp group of companies. The order declares that the Companies Special Investigations Act 1958 shall cease to apply to 2 of those companies. The companies concerned are Allied Farmers Nominees Limited and Yates Nominees Limited.

## Notes

### **1**    *General*

This is a consolidation of the Companies Special Investigations Order (No 6) 1989 that incorporates the amendments made to the legislation so that it shows the law as at its stated date.

### **2**    *Legal status*

A consolidation is taken to correctly state, as at its stated date, the law enacted or made by the legislation consolidated and by the amendments. This presumption applies unless the contrary is shown.
