Customs Export Prohibition Amendment Order 1998: expired, on 1 October 2002, pursuant to clause 1A of the Customs Export Prohibition Order 1996 (SR 1996/233).

### **1 Title and commencement**

- (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Export Prohibition Amendment Order 1998, and is part of the Customs Export Prohibition Order 1996<sup>1</sup> (“the principal order”).
- (2) This order comes into force on 1 December 1998.

Clause 5 of the principal order is amended by revoking paragraph (b).
