

Children, Young Persons, and their Families (Residential Care) Amendment Regulations 2000

Pursuant to section 447 of the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families (Residential Care) Amendment Regulations 2000.
- (2) In these regulations, the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families (Residential Care) Regulations 1996¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 20 October 2000.

3 Interpretation

Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the definition of **internal examination**.

4 Right to personal privacy

Regulation 7(1) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “regulations 41 and 42 of these regulations”, and substituting the expression “regulation 41”.

5 Right to be given instructions verbally

Regulation 9(2) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “or regulation 42(5)”.

6 Regulation 42 revoked

Regulation 42 of the principal regulations is revoked.

7 Power to seize articles, etc, found on search or examination

Regulation 45 of the principal regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subclause (1) the expression “or regulation 42”; and
- (b) by revoking subclause (2)(c).

8 Daily log

Regulation 54(2)(f) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “or regulation 42(6)”.
