Order

1 Title

This order is the Central Institute of Technology Disestablishment and Incorporation into Wellington Institute of Technology Order 2001.

2 Commencement

This order comes into effect on 1 July 2001.

3 Central Institute of Technology disestablished and incorporated into Wellington Institute of Technology

The polytechnic that, immediately before the commencement of this order, is known as the Central Institute of Technology is—

- (a) disestablished; and
- (b) incorporated into the polytechnic known as the Wellington Institute of Technology.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 2001, disestablishes the Central Institute of Technology and incorporates it into the Wellington Institute of Technology (formerly Hutt Valley Polytechnic).
