Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Health and Safety in Employment (Mining Administration) Amendment Regulations 2010.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Health and Safety in Employment (Mining Administration) Regulations 1996.

4 Certificate of competence of manager of underground coal mine

- (1) Regulation 11(1) is amended by omitting “subclauses (2) and (3)” and substituting “subclause (2)”.
- (2) Regulation 11(2) is amended by omitting “more than 8 people but”.
- (3) Regulation 11(3) is revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend regulation 11 of the Health and Safety in Employment (Mining Administration) Regulations 1996.

Regulation 11 provides for managers of underground coal mines to hold certain certificates of competence. The amendments remove references to a certificate of competence as a coal mine deputy. This means that a manager of an operation in which an underground coal mine is worked by not more than 15 people underground at any one time must hold either a certificate of competence as a first-class coal mine manager or a certificate of competence as a coal mine underviewer.

Notes

1 *General*

This is a consolidation of the Health and Safety in Employment (Mining Administration) Amendment Regulations 2010 that incorporates the amendments made to the legislation so that it shows the law as at its stated date.

2 *Legal status*
