- 1 Title**
 These regulations are the Student Allowances (Budget 2017—Accommodation Benefit) Amendment Regulations 2017.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2018.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Student Allowances Regulations 1998 (the **principal regulations**).

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2018, replace Schedule 3 of the Student Allowances Regulations 1998.

Schedule 3 relates to the accommodation benefit payable under regulation 24(1) (to students other than those to whom regulation 24A applies).

Schedule 3 currently provides that the maximum weekly value of that accommodation benefit is,—

- for a single student with a supported child or children, \$60 per week; and
- for any other student, \$40 per week.

New Schedule 3 ensures that the maximum weekly value of that accommodation benefit is, for any student, \$60 per week.
