Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 17 March 2017, amend the Electronic Identity Verification Regulations 2013 (the **principal regulations**). The principal regulations are made under the Electronic Identity Verification Act 2012 (the **Act**).

The Act provides for the Electronic Identity Verification Service (the **Service**) which, among other things, enables a person to verify his or her identity online in order to meet the identification requirements of participating agencies in relation to certain transactions and services. The Service also enables entities that are declared by regulations to be participating agencies to verify a person's identity by electronic means, provided they have the person's consent.

These regulations add 8 individually named bodies to those declared by regulation 4 of the principal regulations to be participating agencies for the purposes of the Act.
