1 Title

This order is the Royal Commission of Inquiry into the Attack on Christchurch Mosques on 15 March 2019 Amendment Order 2020.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 24 April 2020.

3 Principal order

This order amends the Royal Commission of Inquiry into the Attack on Christchurch Mosques on 15 March 2019 Order 2019 (the **principal order**).

4 Schedule amended

In the Schedule, clause 11(1), replace “no later than 30 April 2020” with “on 31 July 2020, or such earlier or later date as is determined by the Minister of Internal Affairs, after consultation with the Attorney-General and the chairperson of the inquiry”.
