1 Title

This order is the Apple Transitional Export Quota Act Commencement Order 2023.

2 Commencement of Apple Transitional Export Quota Act 2022

The Apple Transitional Export Quota Act 2022 comes into force on 31 May 2023.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings the Apple Transitional Export Quota Act 2022 (the **Act**) into force on 31 May 2023, which is the date on which the Free Trade Agreement between New Zealand and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (the **FTA**) comes into force.

The Act enables New Zealand to implement its commitment to administer a transitional quota for apple exports (*see also* the United Kingdom Free Trade Agreement Legislation Act 2022).

Notes

1 *General*

This is a consolidation of the Apple Transitional Export Quota Act Commencement Order 2023 that incorporates the amendments made to the legislation so that it shows the law as at its stated date.

2 *Legal status*

A consolidation is taken to correctly state, as at its stated date, the law enacted or made by the legislation consolidated and by the amendments. This presumption applies unless the contrary is shown.

Section 78 of the Legislation Act 2019 provides that this consolidation, published as an electronic version, is an official version. A printed version of legislation that is produced directly from this official electronic version is also an official version.
